## Year 10 students' uniform

Please find a list of reminders and clarifications about uniform below;

- Blazer badges need to be ironed on at home, if you are unable to do this please let us know and we will do it for you next week. (We would advise you to also sew the badges on if possible.)
- No nail polish or acrylic nails.
- No jewellery other than one small pair of studs
- No jewellery inside the mouth including piercings or jewels.
- Shoes should be plain black school shoes.
- If worn, belts should be plain black with a plain buckle. No coloured belts or belts with large metal, silver or gold buckles.
- Strictly no mobile phones or headphones inside the school building. From next week (w/c 11<sup>th</sup> Sept) if these are seen they will be confiscated for 24 hours as stated in our behaviour policy.
- Ties must be worn in a professional way. The top button of the shirt must be done up. The knot of the tie must cover the top shirt button.
- The bottom of the tie must touch the top of the student's skirt or trousers.
