

# Application form for a Year 10 place at Mulberry UTC in September 2018

Mulberry University Technical College (UTC) is a school for girls and boys aged 14-19.

This application form allows students to apply for a place at Mulberry UTC, so they can leave their existing school at the end of Year 9 and join the UTC at the start of Year 10. An adult who has legal parental responsibility for the child applying must complete this form.

The deadline for receipt of online or paper application forms is 5pm on 31st January 2018.

Forms received after this date will be considered after those received on time.

1. Students with Education, Health and Care Plans
2. Students who are, or who have been, looked after by the local authority
3. Students who receive the Pupil Premium
4. The children of members of staff at Mulberry UTC
5. The siblings of current or former students of Mulberry UTC or Mulberry School for Girls
